Founded in 2000, Genome Atlantic is a not-for-profit corporation offering diverse and highly flexible services created to enable Atlantic Canada to reap the economic and social benefits of genomics and associated technologies by helping companies, government departments, and researchers pursue genomics-based solutions to real-world problems.
